Motion to open the meeting: Jason Leinweber, 2nd Jeremy Wunderlich .
Motion to approve last month's minutes: Pat Steuer, 2nd Tara Deland. Treasure's report: Lots of activity due to the time of the year. Total funds \$51,600 in the bank. Still a bit of spending but in a good position. Motion to approve by Caitlin Pollock, 2nd Jenna Badgley.

Old Business

Kenhorst bathrooms are not finished yet, they cannot work on them until after playground ends which is Aug. 10th. We'll get Porta Pottys for the first and second week of practice and by then the bathrooms should be done.

The Alvernia football program will be using the Kenhorst field during the day before us. They will mow and line the fields for us. Their coach is coming over to look at the shed and meet with Aaron. They will also store some of their equipment in our shed. They have signed a 5-year deal with the borough of Kenhorst. They also plan to build a pavilion in case of inclement weather.

League Updates

- Cocalico and Conrad Weiser requested running only JV teams b/c they didn't have enough kids to field a Varsity. The league voted against this so they left the BICYCL league and went to the BAFL League. Hamburg and Schuylkill Valley may come to BICYCL next year.
- As of now, we have no bye weeks. We have 5 home games and 4 away games. The JV schedule is not completed yet. We will get the schedule out as soon as possible.
- There is a possibility that EMTs will be on the field next year, the league is looking at pricing. The average is \$180 per game for an EMT. Other schools are taking precautions. For example Cocalico has new helmets that are \$250 each that sends an iPad a signal on impact. They have to be recalibrated each year. Sherri Wunderlich suggested reaching out to Reading's Allied Health program which has EMTs that run it for Penn State Berks.

New Business

- Fundraising: We still do not have a volunteer to oversee the snack bar. Tara and Meghan have volunteered to help and Monica will be coordinating the Sign Up Genius for both volunteer time slots as well as donations, but we still need more help to coordinate. We stress the need for volunteers this season, otherwise we will need to increase the registration fees for next year by \$35 to offset the cost of the snack wagon which pays the referee fees (approximately \$6,000 per year). This is in addition to the \$50 fundraising fee, effectively raising the fundraising fee to \$85. If spots are not filled by your team parent volunteers, then an Assistant Coach will be responsible to work in the snack bar.
- Fundraiser cards will be handed out by Meghan Hafer. We have some new vendors this year. Each family gets one set of cards.
- There will be an NFL Pick League Fundraiser this season, more information will be emailed out to everyone soon. It will be \$44 for the Broncos and \$45 for Mifflin Football (difference in price so we can distinguish who is from what organization). There will be a winner each week. For every 100 people who sign up, there is a \$2,000 fee to the organization. We will be splitting it with the high school football program in proportion to how many people from which organization sign up.

We have 2 JV coaches positions still available. Please see a board member if you are interested or know someone who is interested.
